After a two year tour with the United States Army, I began my business career with General Electric Company as a Cost Accountant. In 1968 I took a job as Plant Accountant for Electron research and Fryling Manufacturing Company, two divisions of Erie Technological Products, a global manufacturer of capacitors and resistors. I was promoted to Plant Controller for the Erie division and two years later to Corporate Accounting Manager for the worldwide operations.
